Phil Lape won the bring back raffle last month, so Phil your on the hook for June's meeting.

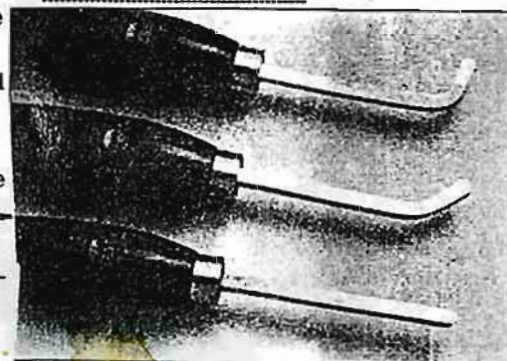
P.A. SYSTEM

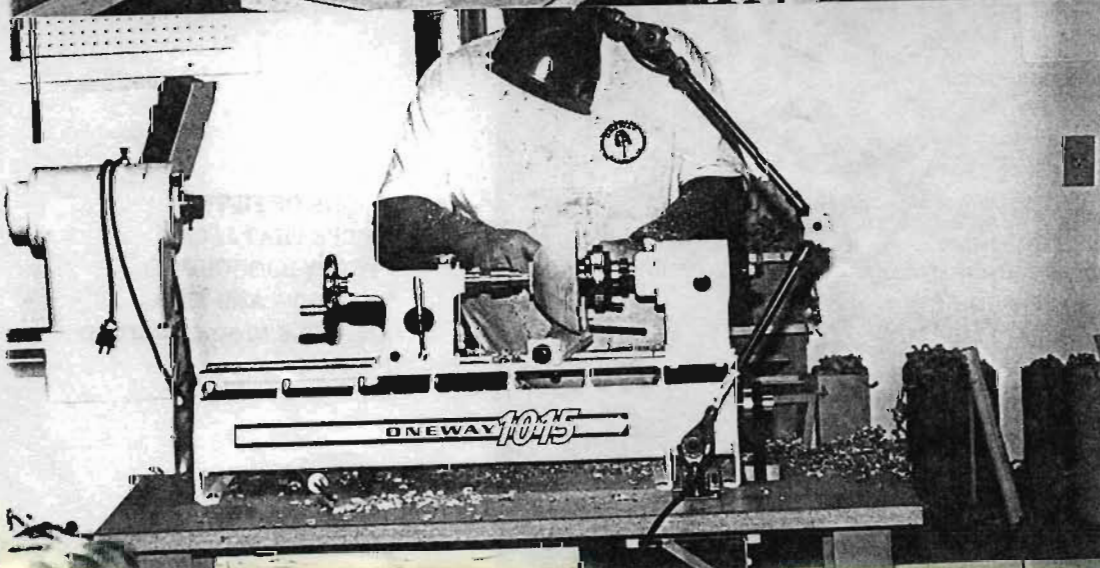

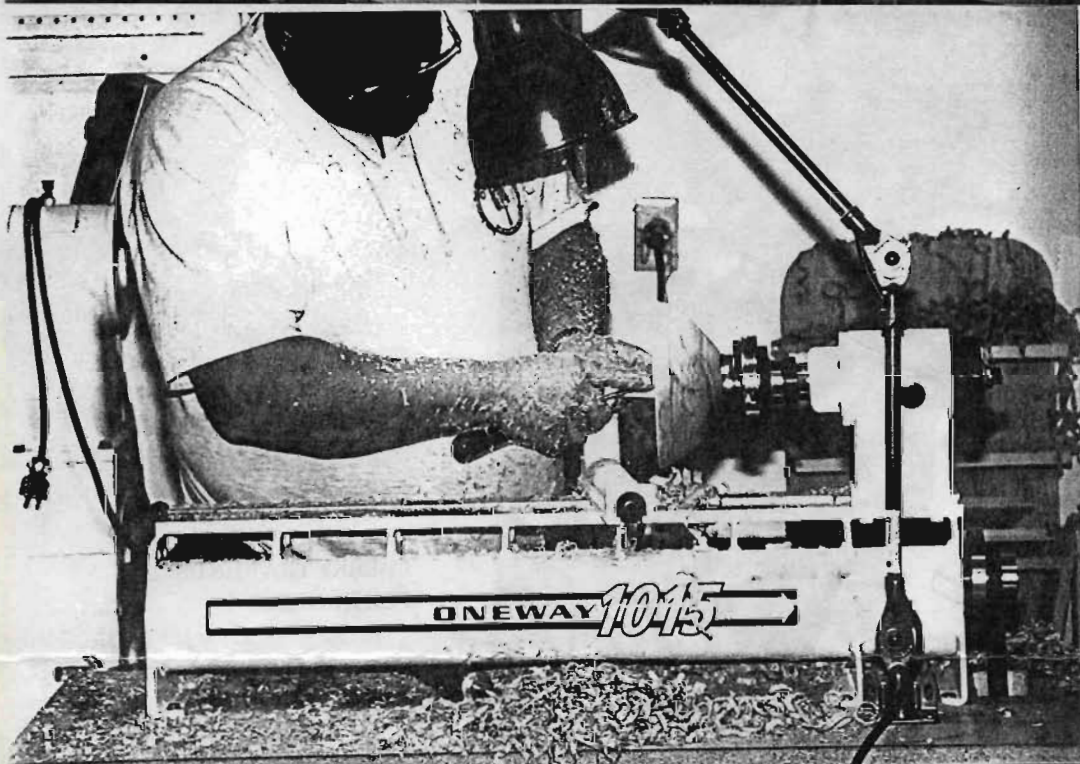
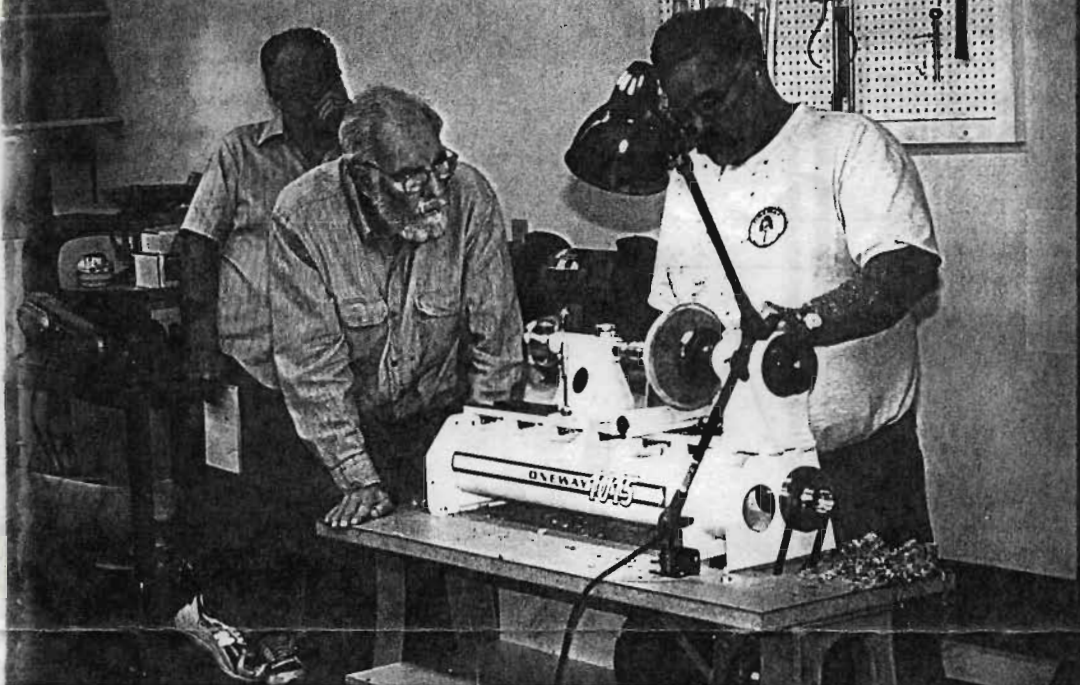
