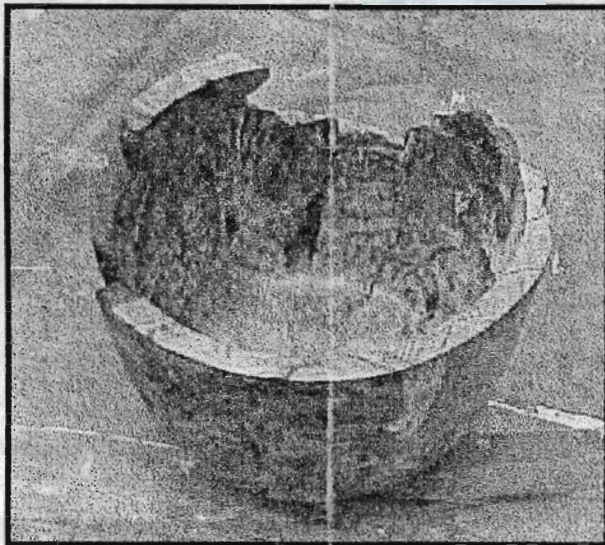
## Let Us Demonstrate
